

Components of Medical Terms

- 1 Word root: General meaning of the term, usually indicates part of a _____ system.
- **2** Combining vowel (often -o): Combines word ______ together, or word root root with suffix.
- 3 Prefix: Added to the ______ of the term, modifies meaning and provides info about:
 - ▶ Direction, position, quantity, time, size, opposite, etc.
 - Not _____ term has a prefix.
- 4 Suffix: Added to the _____ of the term, modifies meaning and provides info about:
 - ► Condition/disease, procedure, action, location, etc.

 - ► Then the _____: indicates direction, position, quantity, etc.
 - Finally, the **word** _____: core meaning of the term.

EXAMPLE

From the given word parts, construct a full term and interpret its meaning.

anti- = against.
path/o = disease.
-genic = producing.

epi- = above/over.gastr/o = stomach.-algia = pain.

STEP 1: Determine if combining vowel is necessary.

• Use vowel when suffix starts with a consonant, don't use vowel when suffix starts with a vowel.

• Use vowel when combining 2 word roots together.

STEP 2: Add suffix to end of word root.

STEP 3: Add prefix to beginning of word root.

STEP 4: Interpret the meaning.
