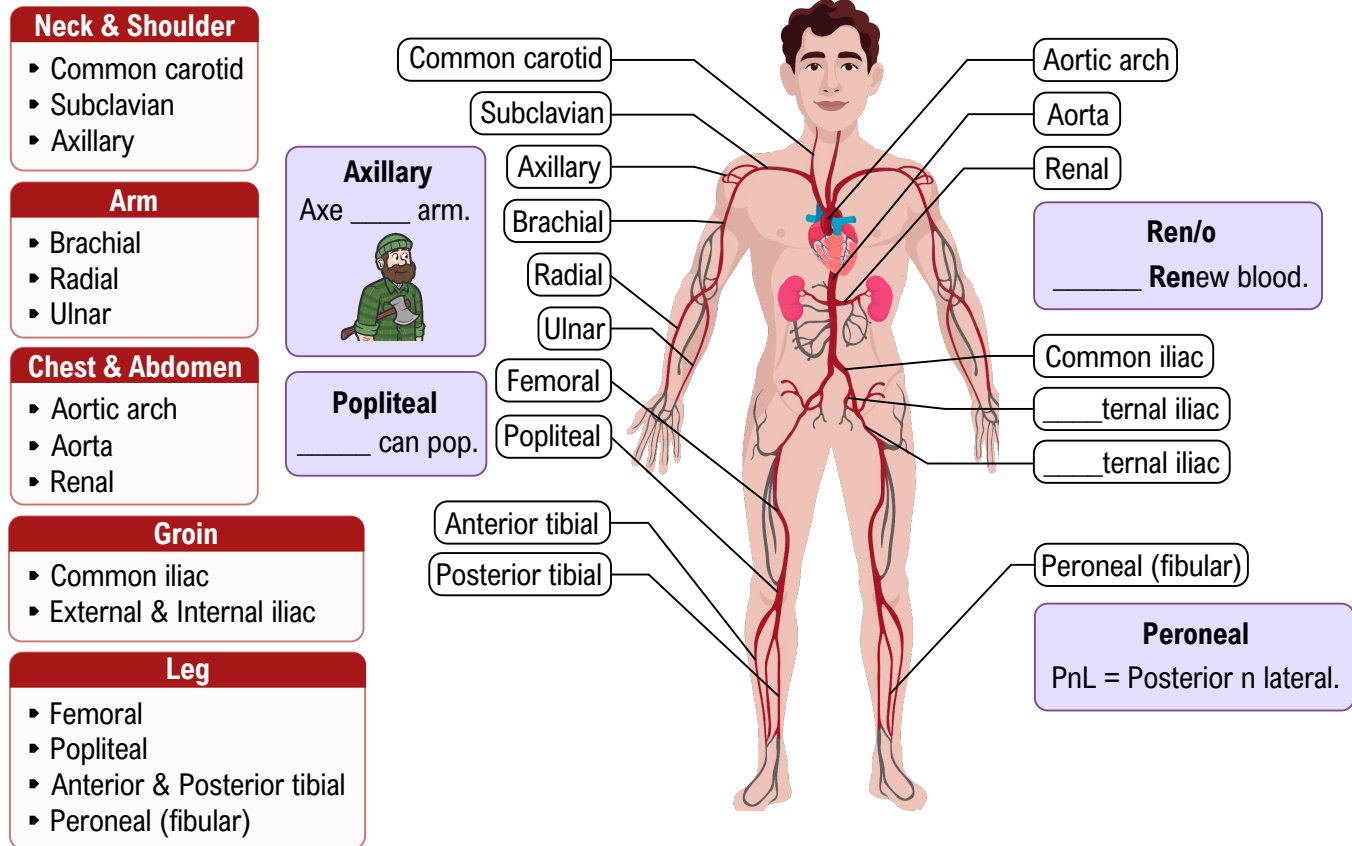

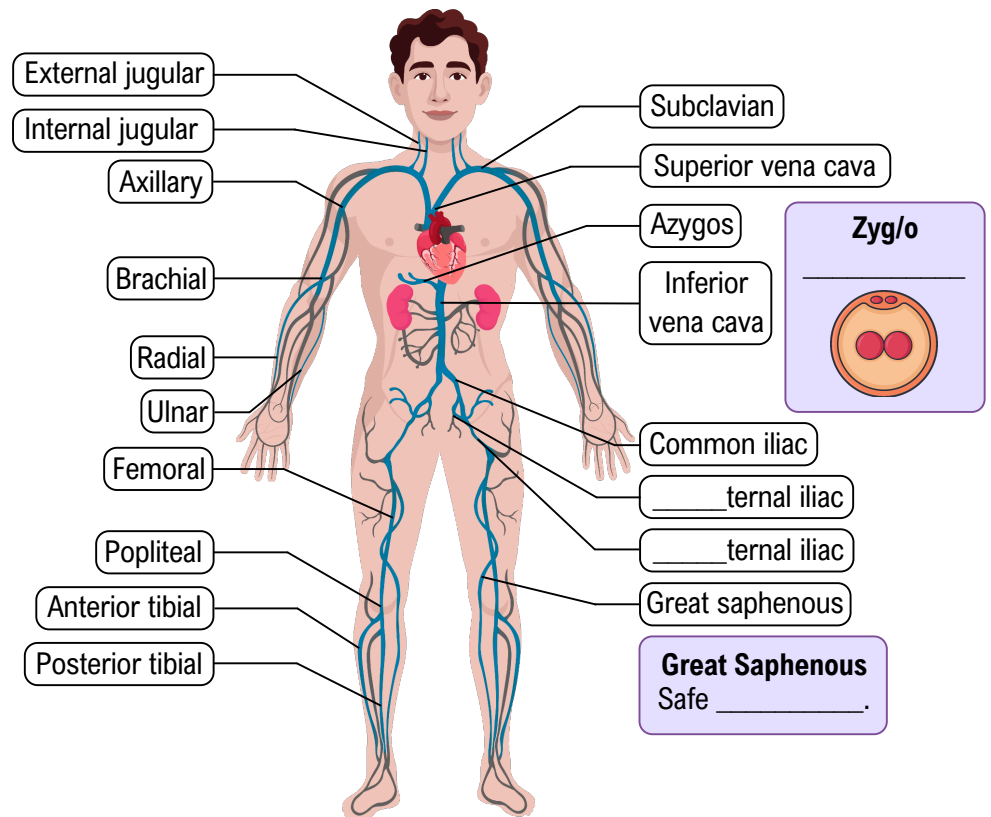

Major Veins

Neck & Shoulder
▶ External & Internal jugular ▶ Subclavian ▶ Axillary
Arm
▶ Brachial ▶ Radial ▶ Ulnar
Chest & Abdomen
▶ Superior & Inferior vena cava ▶ Azygos
Groin
▶ Common iliac ▶ External & Internal iliac
Leg
▶ Femoral ▶ Great saphenous ▶ Popliteal ▶ Anterior & Posterior tibial
