

## **CONCEPT: INTRO TO INFECTION**

◆ **Infection:** Entry and growth/multiplication of a microorganism \_\_\_\_\_ a host.

- Microorganism = infectious agent or \_\_\_\_\_.
- Host = another organism.

### **Infectious Agent**

A microorganism that causes an infection.


### **Pathogen**

A microorganism that causes a \_\_\_\_\_.

◆ Infection becomes a disease when it produces noticeable \_\_\_\_\_ and interferes with life.

## **Stages of Infection**

◆ Infection is a complex process and involves various stages.



◆ **Incubation Period:** from exposure to the \_\_\_\_\_ of symptoms. ◆ **Prodromal Period:** \_\_\_\_\_ symptoms appear.
