



## **Units of Language**

◆ Language is made up of several essential building blocks:



- ◆ Sentences follow syntax rules: indicate \_\_\_\_\_ words can be combined, and in what \_\_\_\_\_.
  - Ex: English uses subject-verb-object "The dog fetched the ball." / "Fetched the ball the dog."
  - Ex: Adjectives before nouns "The fuzzy cat." / "The cat fuzzy."
